(Standard Agreement)

SCOPE OF WORK

1. This Agreement entered into by and between the California Workforce Investment Board, hereinafter referred to as CWIB, and the San Luis Obispo County Workforce Investment Board, hereinafter referred to as Contractor, for the purpose of reimbursing contractor staff time. The Contractor staff is to work with California State University Northridge Dr. Richard Moore and his research team to gather information for the second, summative phase of the Integrated Services Delivery (ISD) Evaluation. This evaluation phase will measure the impact of integrated services learning lab innovation through a "matched pairs design" which compares the experience of One Stops using the ISD model with similar One Stops not using the ISD model.

The CSUN team will choose a single One Stop for study and staff will need to assist in gathering data on the following dimensions of program impact to be measured in the evaluation:

- Volume and type of services delivered
- Customer Satisfaction with services delivered
- Cost of Services delivered using the Activity Based Cost Accounting methodology
- Performance as measured by federal performance measures

Your participation and any information will be treated as confidential. Only the CSUN research team will be able to connect your data with your site. The study will not identify your local area, your One-Stop or any individual in any report or presentation.

The Contractor may invoice for the full amount of the contract after it has provided necessary data to the CSUN team. The Contractor must invoice and the full amount must be expended by June 30, 2011. CWIB contract administrator will work closely with the CSUN research team to ensure data have been provided.

2. The term of this Agreement will be effective upon receipt of the final executed copy through June 30, 2011.

BUDGET DETAIL AND PAYMENT PROVISIONS

1. INVOICING

- A. 2. BUDGET CONTINGENCY CLAUSE

- A. It is mutually agreed that if the Budget Act of the current year and/or any subsequent years covered under this Agreement does not appropriate sufficient funds for the program, this Agreement shall be of no further force and effect. In this event, the State shall have no liability to pay any funds whatsoever to Contractor or to furnish any other considerations under this Agreement and Contractor shall not be obligated to perform any provisions of this Agreement.
- B. If funding for any fiscal year is reduced or deleted by the Budget Act for purposes of this program, the State shall have the option to either cancel this Agreement with no liability occurring to the State, or offer an agreement amendment to Contractor to reflect the reduced amount.
