

Community Based Services Update

In response to a lower unemployment rate, and the barriers experienced by the long-term unemployed in a healthy labor market, Goodwill, as AJCC Operator, has prioritized community outreach and partnership development in PY 16-17. Our goals are to expand our active referral network with partner agencies and to provide career development and vocational training services to participants receiving already receiving community services. So far this year, AJCC has participated in 36 events to promote services to the public/partners. We are on target to deliver services weekly in North and South Counties. In the second half of the program year, our expansion plans include co-locating an AJCC Job Developer at Cuesta College; outreach to libraries, shelters, sober living homes; and utilize WIOA funds to support participants enrolled in Goodwill's fatherhood involvement, homeless veterans, CalWORKs, and probation programs.
